Today we ask God to help us be more playful...

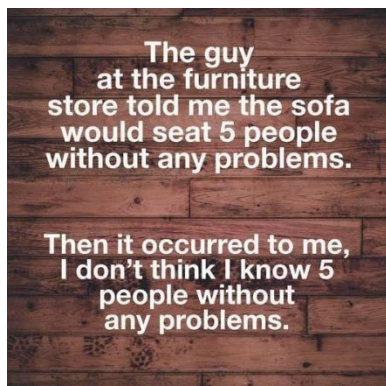
A prayer:
