mouths of the lambs.*

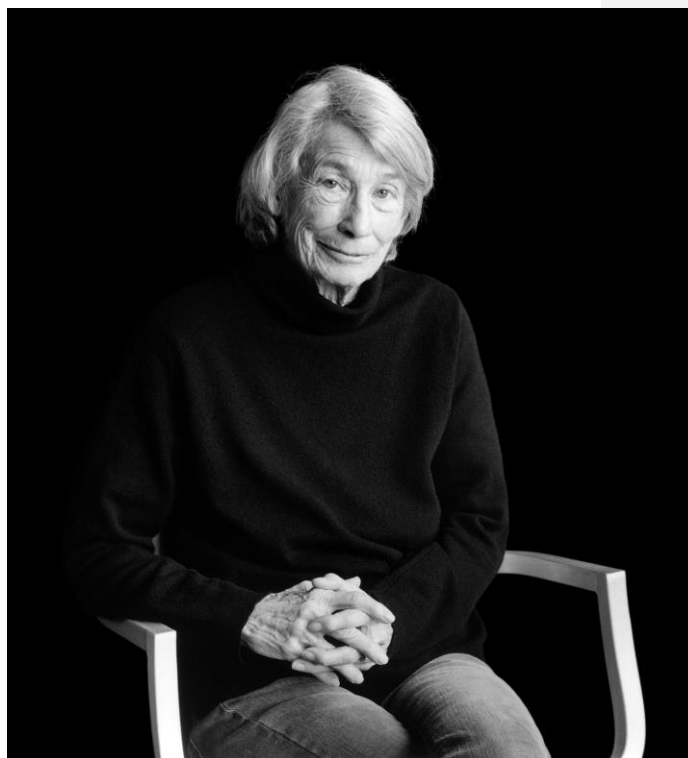
*How rivers and stones are forever

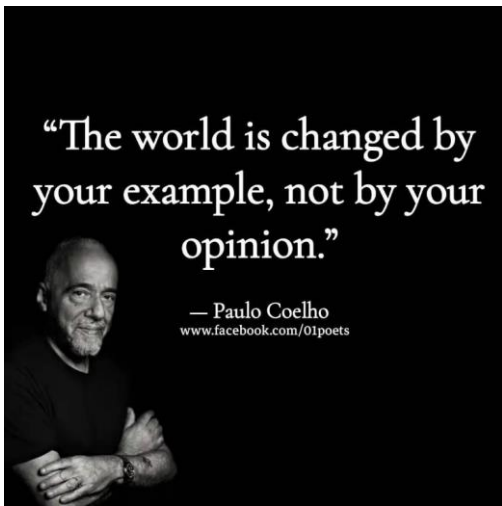
*And now, a little silliness....(aka, Groaners)*
