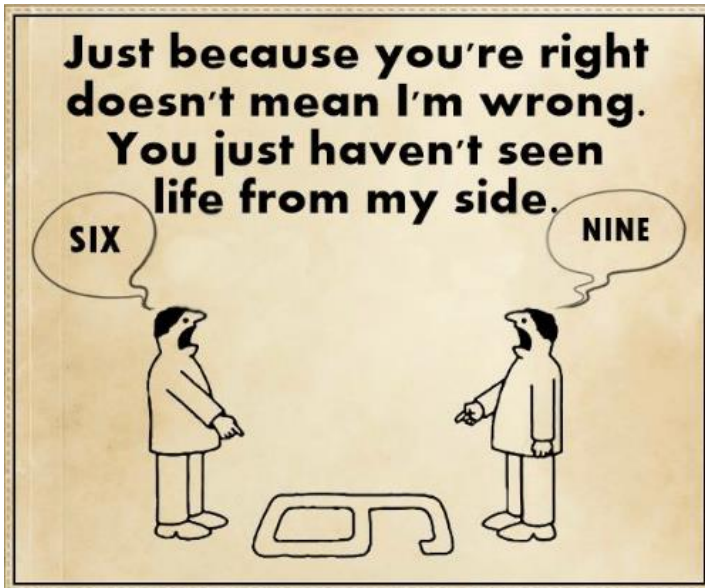


Thoughts and Smiles – January 22, 2024

Of a celebrated glory

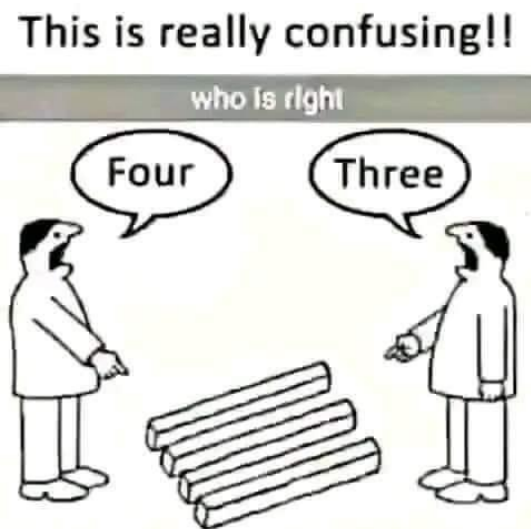
Because it all depends you see
